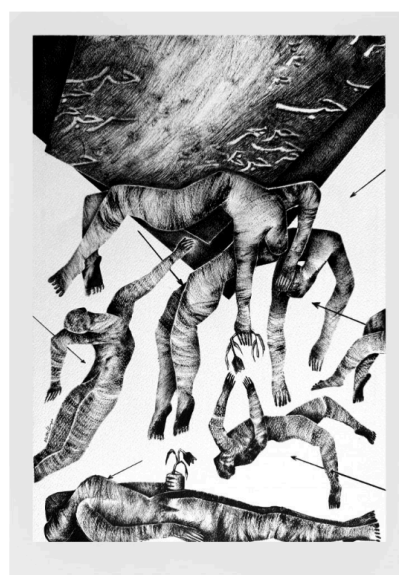
Art is in the air in the city of light, as the wheelers and dealers, collectors, curators, and VVIPs flock from London to Paris. Beyond the main event at the Grand Palais, there are myriad satellite fairs to check out, from the rise of dealer-run fairs like 7 Rue Froissart, Upstairs Art Fair, and Place des Vosges, to the more established events like Paris Internationale and Asia Now. Below, we've rounded up the must-see fairs in Paris this week.

In its sixth edition, Menart Fair returns with a program highlighting artists from the Middle East and North African regions coming from 40 galleries across 18 countries. Victoria Jonathan is curating a special feature called Project Room 2025, with the title "Slow and steady Wears the Stone" and conversations include topics like Paris's role in the avant-gardism of Modern Iranian art, artistic ecosystems in Syria, Palestine, and Lebanon, and a panel on contemporary Tunisian craft.
